

Open Call PROGRAMME FOR CEPRA VISITING FELLOWS

The newly created **Center for Economic and Political Research on Aging (CEPRA)**, established in the Institute of Economics at Università' della Svizzera Italiana (www.cepra.eco.usi.ch), is opening the 2013 Visiting Fellows Program.

The program is open to active researchers working in all fields related to Aging, Fiscal Federalism, Political Economy and Economics of Pensions, who are interested in visiting CEPRA at Lugano (Switzerland) in 2013 for a short period of time (1 or 2 weeks).

Visiting fellows will be part of the Institute of Economics. They are expected to participate to seminars, social events, and meetings, and to interact with CEPRA members and graduate students. The aim of the program is to strengthen contacts with CEPRA researchers, and possibly to lay the foundations for joint projects. Successful candidates are requested to give a seminar and to contribute to the CEPRA Working Paper Series.

CEPRA will cover travelling expenses and accommodation. Visitors will also be provided with fully equipped office space.

Interested scholars should apply by e-mail (idep.eco@usi.ch). 'Visiting CEPRA' should appear in the heading of the message. The application should include the candidate's CV (including all recent publications in peer-reviewed journals and the research fields of interest), and the topics (or short abstracts) of their ongoing research. Applicants sharing research interests with CEPRA members will be given special attention.

There is no formal deadline to apply, as applications are considered on a rolling basis. A first selection will take place in December 2012. Hence, applying soon is an asset.
